Registration

A Registration link for the 85th FirstEnergy All-American Soap Box Derby World Championship (FEAASBD) will be sent to your email. If you do not see the email please check your SPAM folder. If you are still unable to locate the email, contact marketing@soapboxderby.org.

If this is your Champ's first time qualifying for the World Championships, a birth certificate must be sent to the office to complete registration.

Below is information you'll need to have with you while registering your Champ:

- **ASSIGNED CAR NUMBER:** Champs car numbers will be included in the email that you receive with your registration link. This is not the same number you used at a local or rally race.
- **INTERESTS AND ACTIVITIES:** During Race Week, your Champ's favorite activities and career interests will be shared at the Welcoming Ceremony and during the Challenge Races.
- **MEDICAL INFORMATION:** Medical information for each Champ must be provided. Information includes an emergency contact, allergies and medical conditions.
- **CAR HANDLER INFORMATION:** This is the name and cell number of your car handler; the person who can be reached while at Derby Downs.
- **AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE(S):** Cars can only be checked-out upon completion of the World Championship race. Only the authorized representatives will be permitted to check-out the car. Representatives must provide ID to check-out the car.

Car Delivery Schedule

The dates and times listed below are when cars must be dropped off for inspections:

BY CRATE:

July 1, 2, 3, 5 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

– All cars being shipped need to be delivered to 1000 George Washington Blvd., Akron, Ohio, 44312

IN PERSON:

July 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.*

July 11 from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.

July 12 from 9 a.m. to noon

– All cars being dropped off in person should be delivered to 789 Derby Downs Road, Akron, Ohio 44312*

**We are encouraging in-person drop-offs to do so as early as possible, preferably on Sat. July 6 and Sun., July 7. If you drop off on those two days, you may drop your cars at Topside for inspections vs. at the bottom of the hill by HQ.*

Please note that all cars must arrive at Derby Downs with only four (4) screws attaching the body to the floorboard. The remaining body mounting screws are to be placed in a baggie and taped to the car's floorboard.

Shipping Crate Instructions

If you are planning to ship your Champ's car in a crate, please review the following information. (Additional instruction and diagrams can be found at the end of this handbook.)

- The Soap Box Derby is not responsible for the crate shipment arriving or departing Derby Downs.
- The crate must consist of a minimum of 1/2" plywood or particleboard mounted to a 2" x 4" frame. Do not use cardboard
- The crate must have a minimum of 3" high spacers on the bottom of the crate so that it may be easily moved with a tow motor.
- Crates will be stored outdoors for up to three weeks. Please ensure that proper building and painting materials are used for weather resistance in outdoor conditions.
- The lid of the crate must be painted with the following shipping address: International Soap Box Derby 1000 George Washington Blvd. Akron, OH 44312
- Attach the lid with drywall screws. Do not use nails or glue
- Your Champ's AASBD World Championship Car Number, Local Race City Organization, and state or province must appear on all four (4) sides of the crate.
- Following the World Championship, the Local Race City Organization is responsible for re-labeling the crate for the return shipment as well as arranging transport.

Car Signage, Lettering and Decoration

- Specific areas of the shell are restricted as to the signage, lettering and decoration permitted. See Photos #13.1 top and side views.
- No signage, lettering, and/or decoration may cover any screw attachments or body openings.
- Section A: All-American Soap Box Derby Number*
 - This decal is only necessary to be put in place at the All- American Soap Box Derby World Championship.

*Note All-American Soap Box Derby Car Numbers will be given during Car Delivery to Topside.

- Section B: Title/National Sponsor(s)**
 - This decal (or decals) must be put in place for all Local races, Rally races, and for the All-American Soap Box Derby World Championship.
- Section C: Local Race City Organization OR Rally Region
 - This section is approximately thirty (30) inches wide and limited by the height of the shell.
 - At the All-American Soap Box Derby World Championship, this section must include the participant's Local Race City Organization OR the
 - Rally Region that the participant is representing. Lettering must be a minimum of 1-1/2" in height.
 - Optional signage, lettering, and decoration in this section may include the car's sponsor and/or the participant's name.

**Decals provided by the International Soap Box Derby, Inc. or your Local Race City Organization

VIP Status

VIP status is determined by your inspection results. VIP status is awarded to cars with little or no errors. A VIP sticker will be placed on the car by an official.

Non-VIP status occurs when officials find several errors in your car which need to be corrected.

All VIP and repair lists will be posted on aasbd.soapboxderby.org on the evening of July 13. If you have a question about a repair please wait until check-in on July 14 and look for a Race Commission member in the repair tent.

Pre-Orders: Wheels and Parts

Orders for parts can be placed through the online store commerce.soapboxderby.org through July 12. To pick up your order during Race Week, select customer pick-up on the store under shipping selections.

For all PRE-ORDER pick-ups during Race Week you will need to:

1. Visit the east entrance of the White Building inside of Topside.
2. Let a staff member know that you are here to pick up a pre-ordered purchase.

To make a NEW PURCHASE during Race Week, visit the east entrance of the White Building inside of Topside.

Champ Wheels

If you want to purchase and keep the championship wheels used by your champ in Saturday's race, you can do so by ordering online at commerce.soapboxderby.org. Search "race week" and you'll see three options for wheels, WH24 USED, WH24 NEW and WH01 USED. Detailed descriptions and prices can be found online.

Champ Apparel

All Champions MUST wear their provided Champion T-shirts each day they are participating in a Race Week activity. The shirts may NOT be altered.

Race Day Tickets

General Admission tickets can be purchased online at aasbd.soapboxderby.org, at the Parts Store during Race Week, or at the entry gate on race day. Champs and one car handler receive free admission. Kids 6 and under also get in free. Champs and Car Handlers will receive a souvenir ticket in their check-in pack on Sunday, July 14.

****Pets are not allowed at Derby Downs during Race Week and on Race Day.**

Box Seating

Box seats are also available in the online store. Box seats include 10 chairs and are located at trackside in front of the Grandstands. These guarantee up-close, action views of the track and reserved chairs, but do not offer covering from the sun or other elements.

Planning Ahead and FAQ

Badges, Hometown Items and Trading

On Monday, July 15, Champs have the opportunity to attend a “Badge Trading” session at Rock the Rec, where they exchange badges and special items they bring from their hometowns. We suggest bringing approximately 300- 600 badges for trading. Families and volunteers will ask the Champs for their badges all week long. We want to make sure that you are aware of this tradition so that your Champs can take part.



Alignment Badges

Each Champ is provided one additional badge for alignment days. The badge will be included in the Champ bag and can only be used to get into Topside during scheduled alignment days. Scheduled alignment days are Sunday, Thursday (All-Star only) and Friday.

Champ Car Messages and Program Messages

Want to write and give a message to a Champ wishing them “good luck” in Saturday’s race? You can now submit messages virtually! Visit aasbd.soapboxderby.org to fill out a Champ car message. These messages will be placed in the Champs’ cars for them to read on Saturday morning before the race. All messages are due by Thursday at 7 pm.

To purchase a good luck message that will be printed in the 2024 Race Day program, visit [the online store](#) and search for Race Week items. Program messages are \$20.

Banners and Signs

Families are encouraged to bring banners to support their Champs. Banners should be no higher than 3’ and no longer than 6’. Do not hang banners on Derby Downs fencing before 7:30 am on Sunday, July 14. Banners posted prior to this time will be removed.

Tents

Do not place or set up tents/canopies on Derby Downs grounds before 7:30 am on Sunday, July 14. Tents set up prior to this time will be removed. Also, when setting up, please avoid the zoned-off areas. The ISBD is not responsible for tents/canopies placed on our grounds or for items left in them.

Planning Ahead and FAQ

Parking

Thurs., July 18 and Fri., July 20

George Washington Blvd. will not be closed to traffic. For the safety of volunteers, racers, families, and staff we will require all to park in the general events lot on Derby Downs Drive on Thursday and Friday. You will not be able to park in the median or grass along George Washington Blvd. on those two days.

Race Day Parking

Located along the road on the way down toward HQ offices (Air Dock side).

Use 789 Derby Downs Drive, Akron, OH 44306 for GPS. Parking is located in gravel and grass lots.

Food Vendors

There will be various food vendors at Derby Downs/Topside throughout Race Week and Race Day, but the days can be long, so it is advised to bring your own food and drinks as well.

ATMs

There are no ATMs located at Derby Downs. There are a number of local and national ATMs that are just a short drive from the grounds.

Water Stations

There will be water stations located throughout Derby Downs for your convenience. The stations will be located at Champ Check-In, Office Tent, within Topside (two stations), at the Starting line, and in Run Out.

Restrooms

There are no permanent, public restrooms at Derby Downs. Restrooms will be located throughout the grounds. Approximate locations are marked on the map of the grounds provided in this handbook.

Sun Protection/Insect Repellent

There is very little overhead coverage at Derby Downs. Tents are allowed, but don't forget sunscreen and other forms of protection. Ohio can also be hot, muggy and buggy in July. Bring plenty of water and insect repellent, as well.

First Aid Kits

First aid kits are available to guests throughout Derby Downs grounds. AED units are located at the Office HQ Building, at Starting Line, and White Building.

For medical emergencies, an ambulance is located at run out during all racing events. In case of a medical emergency, dial 9-1-1 and the ambulance will be dispatched from run out.

Planning Ahead and FAQ

Recycling

Recycle bins will be located next to each water station. Materials we are able to recycle include plastic, paper, and aluminum. Please help us continue our recycling efforts by placing the appropriate items in the recycling bins.

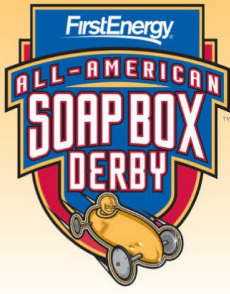

Shipping Crate Instructions

If you are planning to ship your Champions cars in crates to the FirstEnergy All-American Soap Box Derby, please review the following information. The attached diagrams show how crates should be constructed for proper use and storage. We recommend building crates according to the attached drawings.

The following information is mandatory:

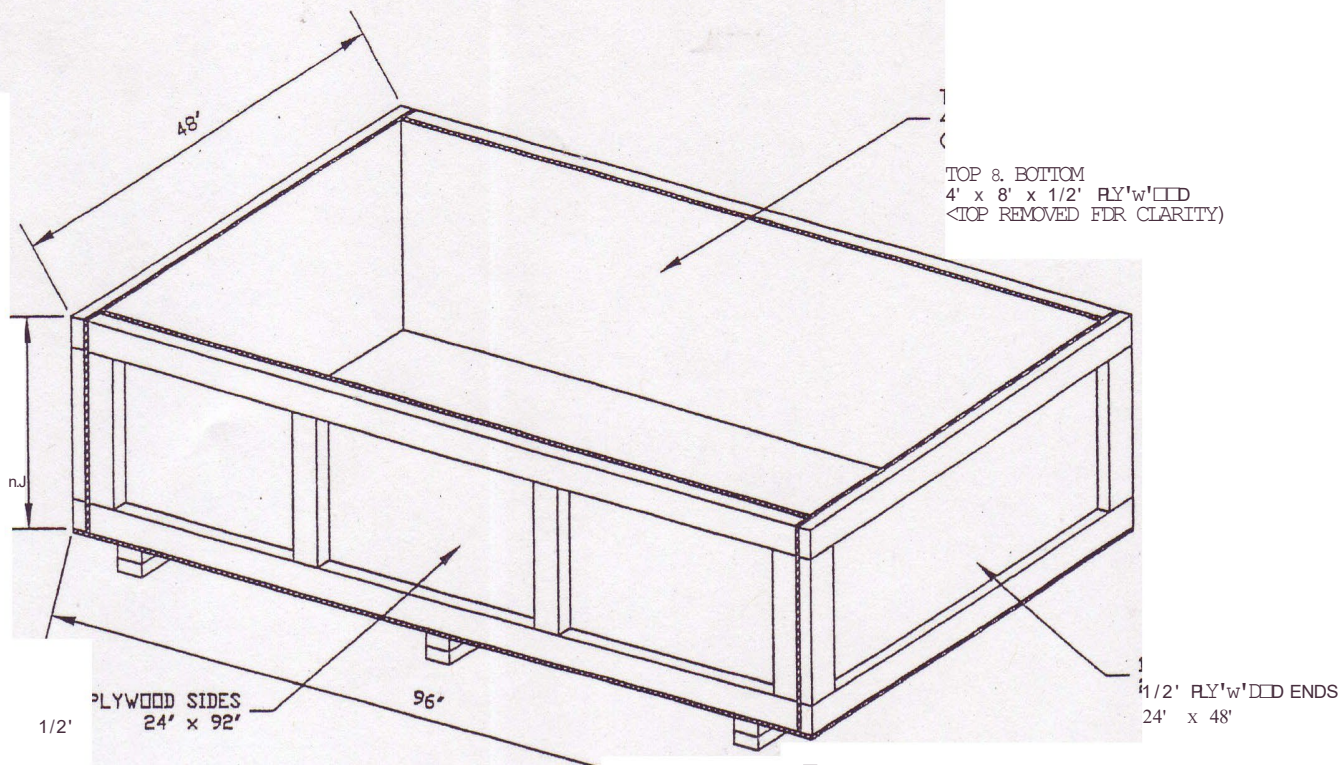
1. The crate must consist of a minimum of 1/2" plywood or particle board mounted to a 2" x 4" frame. Do not use cardboard.
2. The crate must have a minimum of 3" high spacers on the bottom of the crate so that it may be easily moved with a tow motor.
3. Crates will be stored outdoors for up to three weeks. Please ensure that proper building and painting materials are used for weather resistance in outdoor conditions.
4. The lid of the crate must be painted with the following shipping address:

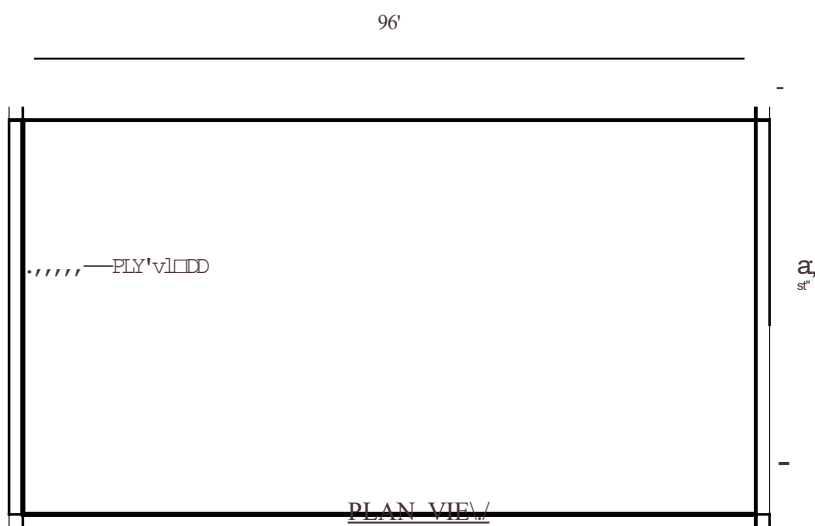
5. Attach the lid with drywall screws. Do not use nails or glue.
6. The Champion's AASBD World Championship Car Number, Local Race City Organization, and state or province must appear on all four (4) sides of the crate.

Following the AASBD World Championship, the Local Race City Organization is responsible for re-labeling the crate for return shipment as well as arranging transport within one (1) week following the race. The AASBD is not responsible for return shipment.

Please note that all cars must arrive to the FirstEnergy All-American Soap Box Derby in Akron, Ohio with only four (4) screws attaching the body to the floorboard. Remaining body mounting screws are to be in a baggie taped to the car's floorboard.

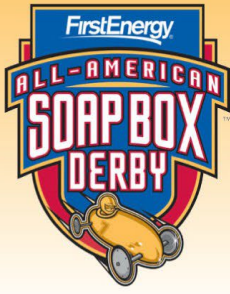

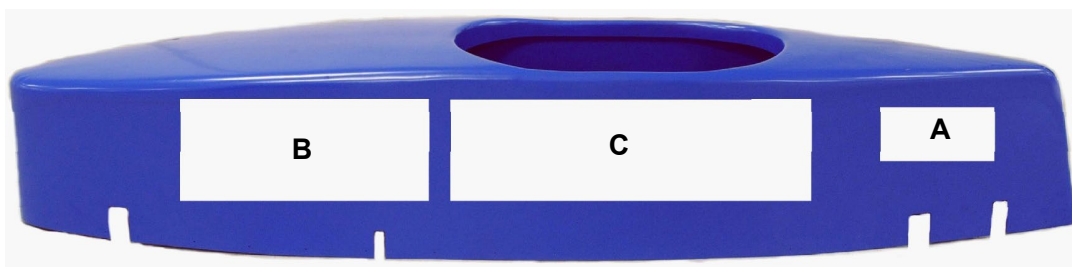


Photo # 13.1 Left Side View

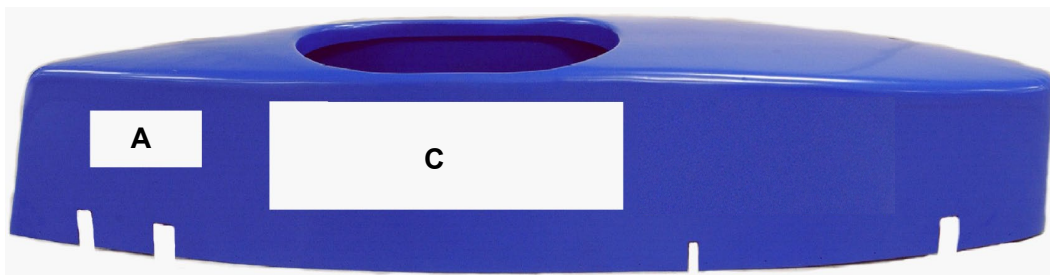


Photo # 13.1 Right Side View

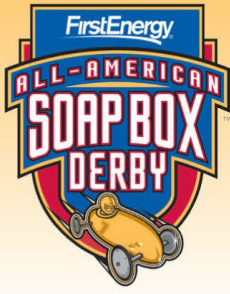
