## **Race Week Scale Procedures**

Weigh day with Champ & Car (Sunday through Friday), the following weights must be achieved. (Chart Weights)

**Stock Division**, a combined weight of an assembled Stock Car, Z-Glass/Uni-grip wheels, and the participant must not be less than one hundred ninety-eight (198) pounds and must not exceed two hundred (200) pounds. Weight distribution is limited to no more than a fifteen (15) pound nose or tail-heavy differential.

**Super Stock Division**, a combined weight of an assembled Super Stock Car, Z-Glass/Uni-grip wheels, and the participant must not be less than two hundred thirty-eight (238) pounds and must not exceed two hundred forty (240) pounds. Weight distribution is limited to no more than a fifteen (15) pound nose or tail-heavy differential.

**Masters Division**, a combined weight of an assembled Masters Car, Z-Glass/Uni-grip wheels, and the participant must not be less than two hundred fifty-three (253) pounds and must not exceed two hundred fifty-five (255) pounds. Weight distribution is limited to no more than a fifteen (15) pound nose and five (5) pound tail-heavy.

All Cars and Champs must weigh in on the day and time they are scheduled unless special arrangements have been made by an approved AASBD Official.
Champs must be in <b>racing</b> position with their helmets on correctly & buckled/strapped while their official weight is being recorded.
Photographs of the Champs in their racing position may be taken by an AASBD official. AASBD officials may use these photos to verify the Champs are in the same position at the starting ramp & finish line.
A Champ's handler may request to view the scale readout for their Champ at the time they are on the scale Sunday and Friday.
Race scales may only be used in the presence of a race official.
The Masters division: The total weight will be recorded with the hatch open, Champ in racing position, and helmet on and fastened correctly. Once the Champ is in position the hatch will be closed to verify tail weight is within specified range.
